Bulky waste



From last year, the bulky waste disposal business will be directly managed by the company. In addition, the following bulky garbage disposal fee is only a reference price because it changes due to changes in the purchase market and the revision of the consumption tax rate.

Reference prices for bulky waste disposal fees (example)

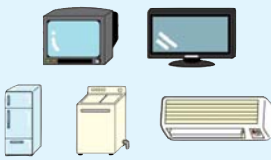

※From this fiscal year, metals with composite materials other than metals, such as small home appliances, will be charged due to the decline in the purchase price.
※For items other than the above, rates for the same or similar items apply.
※The above prices are for one piece, one unit, one bottle, one foot, and one piece.
※If the waste is not separated by type when you bring it in, it will be charged for mixed waste.
※Small home appliances (small appliances that use electricity or batteries) are collected free of charge at the Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center.

Home Appliances 4 Items

For televisions, refrigerators and freezers, washing machines and clothes dryers, and air conditioners, the Home Appliance Recycling Law stipulates that the emitter must pay a recycling fee. Be sure to dispose of it in the following manner.

- Surrender the subject equipment to the retailer who purchased it.
- Turn over the old equipment to the retailer when it is replaced with new eligible equipment.
- If the retailer you purchased the item from is not available or unknown, take it to the Matsukawabata bulky waste/recyclables collection point. (Paid)
- Pay the recycling fee at the post office in advance and ask the following vendors to collect the items

※A collection and transportation fee is required. Please consult with your contractor to coincide with the collection date.

Commercial refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, and vending machines are subject to the Fluorocarbons Recovery and Destruction Law. The collection and destruction of gas is mandatory and the above fees are required.

※If the amount of chlorofluorocarbon gas filling is more than 3kg, please consult with a waste disposal company directly.



Illegal dumping and open-air burning are banned by law!

If you find them, please report them to the Hakuba Village Office or the police immediately

- Outdoor burning and illegal dumping are both punishable by up to five years in prison and a fine of up to 10 million yen.
- The burning of household waste in the open and the incineration of unregulated small household incinerators is prohibited by law.
- It is prohibited by law to dispose of garbage on roads, rivers, forests, etc.
- Please consider the weather and time of day and do not disturb the neighborhood.
- Empty cans, bottles, plastic bottles, cigarette butts, etc. must not be discarded.
- Do not leave the feces of your dog or other animals unattended. It is the owner's responsibility to dispose of them.
- Do not leave your car or other vehicles unattended.

Precautions for use

- In addition to recyclables (newspapers, magazines, cardboard, plastic containers and packaging, etc.), dry cell batteries and fluorescent lights can be brought in free of charge.
- Please separate the items you bring in. If it is not separated, it will be charged for mixed waste.
- If you wish to dispose of bulky garbage during the closure period, please contact Hakuba Village office Resident Division.
- Consider loading the car so that the 4 home appliances can be unloaded first.
- Industrial waste (construction waste, etc.) and hazardous materials (gas cylinders, waste oil, pesticides, etc) are not allowed to be brought in.
- When transporting it by car, tie it tightly to the car so that it does not fall on the road.
- Please be aware that the venue may be crowded from 9am to 10am.
- Never take items of above to the ward/district collection place or small station.

Small home appliances (recycled items)

PCs and Peripherals	PC, Printer, Keyboard, Mouse, Memory card, etc.
Car supplies (electronics)	ETC units, Car navigation system, Car stereo equipment
Hobby Electrical Appliances	Video game console, Portable game console, Controller, Electronic musical instruments
Home Appliances	Fan, Clock, Vacuum cleaner, Air purifier, Lighting fixtures, Electric stoves
Home medical equipment	Hearing aid, Electronic thermometer, Electronic blood pressure, Electric massagers
Cooking appliances	Microwave oven, Rice cooker, Electric pot, Dishwasher, Toaster
Beauty and other home appliances	Iron, Electric razor, Hair dryer, Power tool, Calculator

In accordance with the Small Home Appliance Recycling Law, the resources contained in small home appliances are collected for reuse. Please take them to the Hakuba Clean Center or the Matsukawa Bulky Waste Station. Please note that the Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center will be collected free of charge and the Matsukawa Bulky Waste Station will be collected for a fee.

- ・ Please remove the battery including the built-in.
- ・ Please bring the attached remote control and AC adapter at the same time.
- ・ Electric carpets and electric blankets are not eligible.



Hazardous waste

Dry cells and button cells		Bring them to the ward garbage station, the collection box at the Hakuba Village office, the Matsukawa bulky waste station, and the Hakuba Sanroku clean center. Take out from the bag. If possible, go to the dealer for rechargeable batteries.
Fluorescent lamp Bulb type fluorescent lamp		Bring to the Matsukawa bulky waste station or the Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center without breaking it. Or bring it out to the dealer when you buy a new one. Take out from bag or box.
Mercury thermometers		Don't break it and bring it to the resident Division or the Hakuba Sanroku Clean Center. Do not dispose of it with "glass and ceramic scraps". The alcohol type will dispose of "glass and ceramic scraps". The electronic type will dispose of "metal waste".

All of the above items will be collected free of charge. **Never mix them with "metals" or "glass/ceramic scraps".**

Acceptance of Combustible Bulky Waste at the Kita Alps Eco-Park

Burnable bulky waste that can be brought directly to the North Alps Eco-Park.

- Examples of garbage : Futons, carpets, furniture, grass, branches and trees, plastic products.
- Notes
 - ・ Branches and trees that are 5cm or more in diameter and 180cm or more in length, and furniture that is 5cm or more in thickness are not accepted.
 - ・ Tatami mats and registers are not accepted.
 - ・ If it is less than 50cm long and shredded to less than 5cm thick, and use the designated burnable garbage bag, it can be accepted.
 - ・ Some combustible bulky garbage cannot be accepted, so please consult with the North Alps Eco-Park in advance. (☎0261-85-5311)
- Disposal fee : 200 yen per each 10 kg
