Snow removal on village roads in Hakuba Village is made all possible through the efforts of snow removal companies in the village.

Basically, snow removal is carried out late at night when there are few cars and pedestrians on the roads. In some cases, work is also performed during the daytime in case of sudden snowfall or to remove plowed snow without disturbing others. In other words, they work day and night to maintain Hakuba Village's roads. In addition, snow removal trucks are very large vehicles and require a high level of skill to perform detailed snow removal work. Thanks to these snow removal companies, we are able to keep the roads passable even in Hakuba Village where there is a lot of snowfall.

The dates are the third Sunday of every month from January to March and the following Monday.



Note:

Material must be less than 50 cm in length and less than 5 mm in thickness. The ways differ depending on your town or village.




Plastic containers and packaging

- The Items that cannot be disposed of as plastic products
 - Items that are heavily soiled or stained
 - Items with unknown materials
 - Items with metal attached
 - Items that run on dry cell batteries or batteries
- Material with a length of 50 cm or more
 - Omachi Recycle Park
 - North Alps Eco Park
 - Hakuba Recycle Center
 Can be brought to the above locations on the acceptance date.

Moving out of Hakuba Village



When to another municipality, overseas or foreigner with re-entry permits are required to complete the move-out procedures. Submit a notification of moving out at Hakuba Village Office Resident Division, in advance is necessary.

A move-out notification can be submitted 14 days before your schedules move-out day. Please make sure you or your foreign employees have completed all necessary procedures before leaving Hakuba.

Moving to another municipality

A move-out certificate will be issued immediately after one has reported his/her moving at the village office. Please be aware that a new address municipality without the certificate.

Note: New address is needed when you submit the move-out notification

You can also report your move-out notification by mail

Please scan a QR code and download request form for sending a certificate of the move-out. Request form can be sent by mail with a copy of your I.D, National Health Insurance Card, Seal Registration Card, Welfare Medical Expense Beneficiary Certificate for 18 years old and under, and a stamped envelope.

Moving to abroad:

Submission of move-out notification is necessary even if you have a plan to come back with a re-entry permit.

WHAT IF WE FORGET???

These who have joined the National Health Insurance System, you have to pay Health Insurance Tax for the period that you are out of Japan if you leave Japan without filling a move-out notification properly.

Agriculture and Forestry in Hakuba Village



We have trees on our property that are about to fall over...



▶▶ The basis of forest management is the owner

According to the Forest Management Control Law, the basis of forest management is the responsibility of the owner. In the event that a dead tree happens to fall or a fallen branch hits a third person and causes harm, the owner will be held responsible. The village also believes that the owner is responsible for the management of personal property (forests and trees). However, for those trees that cannot be managed by the owner, since 2021, the village has prioritized those that are likely to cause danger to people and homes by cutting them down, removing the fumigation, and injecting tree trunks as a preventive measure.

In 2020, Hakuba Village began suffering from oak wilt, which killed many of the trees in the village. The village has taken countermeasures such as fumigation of felled trees and injection of chemicals into tree trunks.

We made benches and installed them in the village hall as one of the measures to make people aware of the damage caused by the oak wilt and to utilize the damaged wood.



Sister City Exchange Program

— Kawazu Elementary School and Hakuba Minami Elementary School Exchange —

46 students from Kawazu Town visited Hakuba Village on January 16.

They enjoyed skiing at Able Hakuba Goryu Ski Resort with 5th grade students of Hakuba Minami Elementary school.
